(Saturday morning thru Thursday evening)

WHAT IS NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING?

NYLT is a six-day resident camp learning experience for Troop Junior Leaders: Senior Patrol Leaders, Assistant Senior Patrol Leaders, Patrol Leaders, Troop Guides, Troop Officers and Scouts who have leadership potential in the opinion of their Scoutmaster.

NYLT is conducted by the South Texas Council Training Committee using guidelines provided by the National Council, Boy Scouts of America.

NYLT has these aims:

- To equip the Scout with a toolbox of leadership skills and practical tools that have proven effective in a variety of Scouting and personal leadership situations. This training will directly and positively impact his effectiveness in the Troop.
- To provide participants a chance to meet and work with leaders from other troops for an exchange of ideas and experiences.
- To give each participant experience in Scouting skills and techniques that can be shared with his patrol and troop members back home.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Registered Scouts, 13-17 years of age at course time. **(Age exceptions must be approved by the Course Director.)** Scouts should be First Class or higher in rank. **In order to have a quality event, registration will be limited to the first 48 applicants who meet age and rank requirements.**

LOCATION: Camp Karankawa is located near Mathis, Texas. A map will be sent with an information packet when the reservation is received. This packet will be sent to individual Scout applicants and their Scoutmaster.

DATE: (NOTICE CHANGE) Saturday morning thru Thursday evening!! Participants are to report to the Camp Karankawa Training Center at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 13th, to begin training. Please do not plan on arriving after that time as the course will commence immediately. The course will conclude on Thursday, March 18th. Scouts may be picked up between 8:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. All Scouts must leave by 9:00p.m.

NYLT is a Leadership camp and not a “for fun” oriented camp. If your Scout arrives thinking he will be having an extra week of summer camp, he will be surprised, and most likely upset. **The experience has many fun elements but is geared towards STUDY and APPLICATION.** Scouts who arrive ready to get down to work seem to take the most home from the course. Scouts who arrive with the attitude that they are only here to have fun don't do as well. **(Please inform your Scouts of what is expected of them during this training.)**

The Camp Office with its telephone will be off limits to Scouts unless there is an emergency. Also, please discourage your Scout from routinely using a personal cell phone. Camp Karankawa Phone No.: 361-547-2624. (Emergencies only).

Scouts are absolutely restricted to Camp Karankawa areas only. **ANY SCOUTS FOUND OUTSIDE THE CAMP WILL BE IMMEDIATELY SENT HOME—NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

COST

The full fee is \$140. There is a \$10 discount if all fees are paid in full by February 24th. The Troop or chartered organization often funds a portion (or all) of the attendance fees because the benefits brought to the Troop through

this leadership training are so great. The fee may be paid in full, or in 3 payments with a minimum payment of \$50. The course fee includes a T-shirt. Participants are required to wear BSA class A or B uniform at all times. Limited campership funds are available for needy and deserving youth.

Schedule of payments:

\$50 to be paid with registration

\$80 to be paid on or before February 24th, total of \$130

\$140 total after February 24th.

REFUNDS/CANCELLATION

Written refund requests received at the Scout Service Center more than 35 days before the first day of the camp will be refunded in their entirety except for \$35.00.

Written refund requests received at the Scout Service Center 35 days or less before the first day of the camp and more than 48 hours before the participant's scheduled arrival at camp will be refunded in their entirety except for \$65.00.

Written refund requests received at the Scout Service Center or at camp less than 48 hours before the participant's arrival at camp and up to and including the first meal of the camp session will be refunded in their entirety except for \$100.00.

Written refund requests will be granted, unquestioned, according to the guidelines outlined above. Prepaid camp fees may be transferred to another Scout within the same Scouting unit without a penalty. This refund policy is being enacted to provide the maximum flexibility to Scouts and their families while protecting the council's pre-paid camp expenses based on the unit's reservation numbers.

SCOUTMASTER INVOLVEMENT

NYLT Training is intended to strengthen the scouting relationships between the Junior Leader and his Scoutmaster. Scoutmasters are encouraged to bring their boy leaders to camp and to pick them up at the conclusion of the training. A special orientation session will be held for Scoutmasters on opening day and again on the final day. This will be an opportunity for all Scoutmasters to know the significance of the training their Scouts have received and how to use this to full advantage in the troop back home. Please complete the application form and return it as soon as possible. Remember, only the first 48 applications will be accepted.

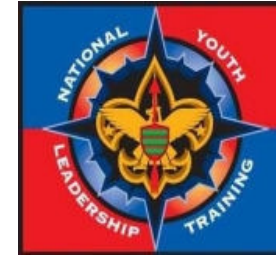
